- Engine oil types, viscosity, change intervals
- Oil filter, air filter, fuel filter, cabin filter – how to inspect & replace
- Coolant: types, mixing ratios, flushing basics
- Brake fluid & power steering fluid basics
- Hands-on: Basic service routine on live vehicle

### Week 3: Mechanical Systems Overview

- Suspension system
- Brake system
